STEEL HANDS BREWING 2018 ARTIST RULES

ELIGIBILITY:

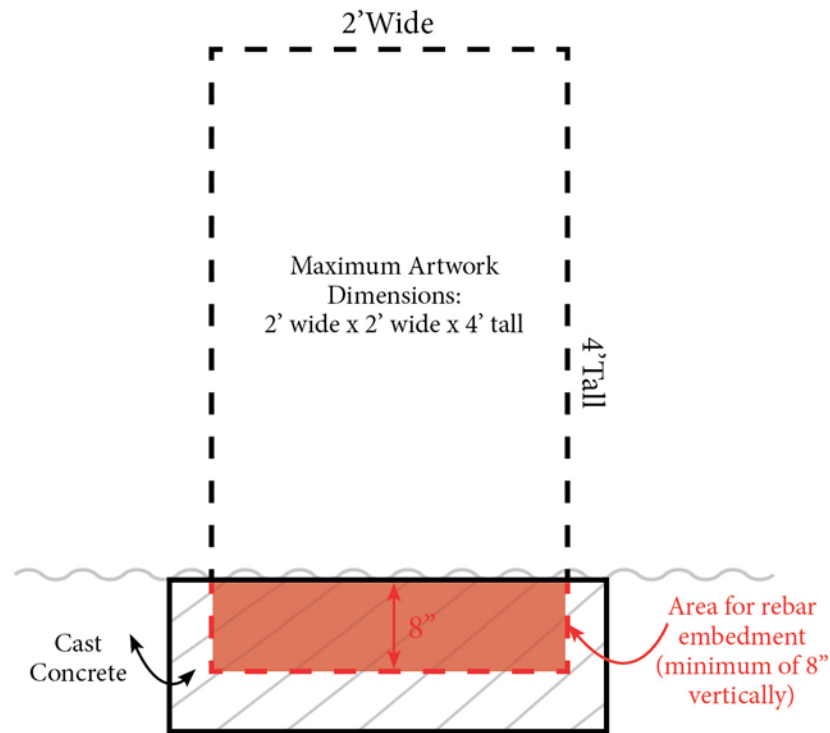
- The artist must be 18 years or older on or before **November 1st, 2018**.
- The artist or artists collaborative groups must live or work within the Cayce area **or a nearby town including West Columbia and Columbia.**
- The artist must submit artwork created by him- or herself. The submission cannot be an identical copy, reproduction or only slightly altered version of someone else's existing work. If the artist's artwork infringes upon another artists' copyright, it will be disqualified at the sole discretion of Steel Hands Brewing. Upon submitting to this competition, the artist is solely responsible for any infringement on copyrighted materials. The artist retains all copyrights to their artwork without exception.
- The artist's submission must be constructed in the media provided by Steel Hands Brewing. Steel Hands Brewing will be providing each artist with an allotment of rebar sourced from neighboring CMC Steel's manufacturing plant.
- The artist's submission must be able to be installed outdoors permanently and withstand the outdoor elements.
- The artist's submission must be one single work of art.
- An artist who submits as part of a collaborative group or collective can also submit as an individual artist and vice versa. A single artist can be a part of a maximum of 3 pieces of artwork.

SUBMISSIONS & FEES:

- Artists or artists collaborative groups or collectives may submit up to 3 pieces of 3-D artwork in the media provided by Steel Hands Brewing. The submission will need to be in the form of a sculpture. All fabrication will be limited to the materials provided by Steel Hands Brewing, however, artists are allowed to paint.

- All submitted artwork must be inspired by our brewery theme. Anything related to the brewing process, breweries, beer or the like will be considered.
- We will be capping the competition with the first 25 entries. In the event there is overwhelming interest, we will consider opening the event to additional entries or provide a waiting list for those interested.
- The submission deadline is **October 15th, 2018**. All sculptures are to be delivered on site. Please make arrangements to contact Ashley Lambert for delivery.
- Steel Hands Brewing has the final decision at all times and in all cases as to how much space will be allotted, and where, to each artwork accepted for permanent display based in part, by not exclusively, on available space and locations as determined by Steel Hands Brewing.
- Submitted artwork has to adhere to size limitations set or provided by Steel Hands Brewing here in the submission rules.
- The maximum dimensions for artwork are **2 feet wide by 2 feet deep x 4 feet tall**.
- Artwork submitted must be ready for installation. Steel Hands Brewing will have the final decision on location for the artwork. The artwork must have a minimum of 8" of vertical rebar at its base that can be cast in concrete so that this artwork maybe be permanently displayed. Artwork must be able to support its own weight once installed. Maximum dimensions do not need to include the 8" vertical rebar for casting.

- Submitted works will be reviewed by a panel of judges determined by Steel Hands Brewing. Artists that submit their artwork will compete for prize money in Cayce, South Carolina and for permanent installation at Steel Hands Brewing.

- There are no fees for submission, however, the artist is responsible for all costs relating to the fabrication of submission but not including the rebar provided by Steel Hands Brewing.

GUIDELINES:

- Submissions will not be for sale at any time once submitted to Steel Hands Brewing.
- Artists must include a title and description for their work.

LOGISTICS:

- The artist is responsible for transportation and cost of transportation of the artwork to Steel Hands Brewing. The artist is not responsible for final installation. Steel Hands Brewing will install the art.

GUIDELINES FOR ARTIST PROMOTIONAL MATERIALS:

- Steel Hands Brewing will be providing a brochure to include each artist's information. The artist is not responsible for the cost of producing promotional materials supplied by Steel Hands Brewing with the artists' information.
- Each artist will be required to submit a headshot, brief description of their artwork, photo of their artwork, and a brief artist biography to be included in our artist brochure. The deadline for the brochure is **October 15th, 2018**.

CONDITIONS:

- Entries will be removed from competition based upon impracticality or impossibility of installation for continued exhibition, or if they create issues with public safety hazards, at the sole discretion of Steel Hands Brewing.
- Entries will be removed from the competition if they are considered politically or radically motivated at the sole discretion of Steel Hands Brewing.
- All participants awarded permanent installation, and the winners of the competition agree to transfer all ownership of and reproduction rights of the artwork to Steel Hands Brewing on **October 15th, 2018**.
- The winner will receive their prize money in the form of a check, sent to the address provided by the artist, within 30 working days after the conclusion of the competition at Steel Hands Brewing.
- Winners shall be solely responsible for all federal, state and local taxes.
- Steel Hands Brewing will have the option to promote Steel Hands Brewing's business during any and all events associated with its display of the artwork at its reasonable discretion during and after the competition.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Does the submitted artwork fit the brewery theme of the competition?
- Is there a creative interpretation of the subject/theme?
- Is the originality of the work interesting?
- Is there overall quality of the medium being used?
- Does the work stand on its own as a complete and outstanding creative image?
- Does the work impact or provoke the viewer in relationship to the theme?
- Does the work make you want to raise a glass and cheers? (Ha, just kidding...)

PRIZE:

- **First prize will be \$1,000.**
- **Second prize will be \$500.**
- All artist's submissions will have the opportunity to have their artwork considered for permanent installation at Steel Hands Brewing. Selected artwork will be permanently displayed at Steel Hands Brewing.

- Artists will also benefit from any PR, social media, website or press releases including information related to the competition by Steel Hands Brewing.

INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT:

- Artist and agrees that in no instance will Steel Hands Brewing be liable to Artist for any claim, suit, action, loss, expense or liability relating to or arising from the Steel Hands Brewing Artist Competition or their respective participation in the Steel Hands Brewing Artist Competition. Artist shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless Steel Hands Brewing and their respective directors, officers, affiliates, agents, and employees, from and against any and all liability, claims, suits, actions, losses and expenses, including costs and attorney fees, relating to or arising out of any claim or demand of any kind or nature which any person or party may make against Steel Hands Brewing based upon or arising out of the fabrication, submission, the location, or any other claim or demand relating to the Steel Hands Brewing Artist Competition. Steel Hands Brewing is the intended beneficiary under this Section.

GENERAL:

- This Agreement and all rights and duties under this Agreement shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of South Carolina.
- This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, by emailed signature pages or otherwise, each of which when so executed will be deemed to be an original and such counterparts will together constitute one and the same Agreement. Neither party may assign this Agreement or delegate rights to duties without the prior written consent of the other party.

IMPORTANT DATES:

- **August 15th, 2018** – Artist Submission Rules & Liability Agreement deadline.
- **October 15th, 2018**
 - Artwork is due to be delivered on site.
 - Headshot, brief description of artwork, photo of artwork and a brief biography for brochure due.
 - Ownership of artwork is transferred to Steel Hands Brewing once delivered on site.
- **November 1st, 2018** – Steel Hands Brewing Artist Competition
- **November 1st, 2018** – All artists must be 18 years of age by or before this date to be eligible to compete.
